

# **CatzRus Adoption Contract**

Thank you for adopting from us – we couldn't keep rescuing without you

## This is the final step before you take your new cat or kitten home with you! Please supply us with the following paperwork:

- 1. The adoption contracts (Page 2 & 3 for us to keep and Page 4 & 5 for you to keep):
  - signed by all parties and witnessed by the foster parent of the cat/kitten.
- 2. Proof of Payment
- 3. Copy of your ID document
- 4. Proof of Residence
- 5. Pet Permission Letter from all the parties involved if the property is not your own (i.e. Body Corporate and/or property owner/landlord).
- 6. If your cat or kitten is not yet sterilised (spayed or neutered) at the time of adoption, please complete and sign the sterilisation agreement.

**NOTE:** If any vaccinations are still due under the adoption fee, please make arrangements with the foster mom. CatzRus will only cover vet costs if the cat is taken to a CatzRus vet.

### Once all the paperwork has been received, it's preparation time:

- 1. Arrange an adoption **date** with the foster parent of your cat/kitten.
- 2. Find out what **food** the cat is eating. We strongly recommend veterinary diets. If you wish to transition your cat onto other vet food, please do it gradually to prevent tummy upsets.
- 3. Prepare your home, property and family for the new arrival. Put mesh over windows and gates as necessary. Educate children and domestic workers not to open windows in the first weeks. Please do all you can to prevent the heartache of a lost kitten. Contact us if kitty escapes – we have some experience in recapturing escapees!
- 4. On adoption day, please remember your secure cat carrier to transport your new family member. It's a big day for them and a cat carrier is essential for their safety and yours.
- 5. On adoption day you will receive:
  - a) Your new cat to love and cherish for a life-time.
  - b) The cat's vet card. Please note the dates for future vet care (sterilisation, vaccinations).
  - c) A micro-chip sticker which can be found in the vet card. (PLEASE CHECK IT IS THERE)
  - d) Your copy of the adoption contract.
  - e) Your copy of the sterilisation agreement (if the cat is not yet sterilised).
  - f) Please remember to transfer the microchip into your name asap after adoption!
